News 01. New TECHCROSS Factory Groundbreaking Ceremony




TECHCROSS held the new factory groundbreaking ceremony on January 13, 2015. The new factory will be located at Shinho industrial complex in Busan. TECHCROSS decided to build the new factory in order to prepare for the tremendous demands for ballast water management systems after the BWM Convention becomes ratified in the near future. The new factory is on a 42,479m² site and includes a SKID factory, the ECS production factory, an office building, and a multi-purpose hall.

Currently, the SKID for mounting the TECHCROSS system for specific applicatio

-ns is outsourced from a third party. However, when the new factory is fully operational, TECHCROSS will have the ability to internally produce over 100 SKID mounts per year. Furthermore, TECHCROSS expects to be able to manufacture over 1,000 complete BWMS per year at the new factory. The new factory will be fully operational by this September.

Regulations 01. Status of BWM Convention Ratification

As of March 10, 2015, 44 countries representing 32.86% of world tonnage have ratified the Ballast Water Management Convention (BWM Convention) with the most recent ratification by Georgia. The BWM Convention shall enter into force 12 months after the date on which not less than 30 states and the combined merchant fleets of which constitute not less than 35% of the gross tonnages of world's merchant fleets have ratified.
